		Institution is a large multidisciplinary medical	
		institution with 10 medical and preventive	
		institutions, 14 specialized departments of the	
		hospital hospital and 10 support services. On the	
		basis of the city hospital, there are 4 inter-district	
		departments (orthopedic traumatology,	
		ophthalmology,urology, infectious diseases), as well	
		as a computed tomography room, the palliative care	
		department of the nursing hospital. 2 interdistrict	
		centers with ACS and ONMC, 2 prenatal diagnostic	

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		rooms (on the basis of women's consultations of polyclinics No. 1 and No. 4), which provide specialized medical care to 10 districts of the Vitebsk region with a total population of about 450 thousand. Every year, more than 7 thousand patients are treated in inter-district departments, which is almost 28% of all those treated in the hospital. New modern diagnostic and treatment methods have been introduced in traumatology, ophthalmology, gynecology, endoscopy, laboratory diagnostics and computed tomography. More than 20 thousand people receive care at the hospital every year.
